Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

1. What does the class look like?

The ground school is open to Private and Commercial Pilot students, so the class has a variety of students from different backgrounds. There could be as few as 5 to as many as 35 students.

2. What days of the week are the classes conducted for Fall?

Each week will differ as to what days (Monday to Thursday) the classes are on depending on that schedule.

3. What time do the classes run?

6pm - 9pm

4. What topics will be covered during the aviation ground school?

- (i)Canadian Aviation Regulations
- (ii) Aerodynamics and Theory of Flight
- (iii) Meteorology
- (iv) Airframes, Engines and Systems,
- (v) Flight Instruments
- (vi) Radio and Electronic Theory
- (vii) Navigation
- (viii) Flight Operations,
- (ix) Licensing Requirements
- (x) Human Factors, including pilot decision-making

5. What does a typical class look like?

Classes are lecture-based. Students will be taught navigation through the Vancouver Maps and other navigation supplies.

6. What type of assessments are conducted?

The ground school runs for about 3 months and the only assessment is a FINAL exam on the entire syllabus.
